Sarah Kapustin- BIOGRAPHY

Sarah Kapustin's musical activities have taken her across **North America, Europe and Australia**, in performances as both soloist and chamber musician. Born in 1981 in Milwaukee, WI, she has performed with such orchestras as the **Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra**, Indiana University Philharmonic, Juilliard Symphony, and the **Pasadena Symphony**. Sarah has received prizes and honors in numerous competitions, most recently 1st prize in the **2007 International Markneukirchen Instrumental Competition**, resulting in a radio broadcast and solo engagements throughout Germany. She has appeared in such prestigious concert venues as **Alice Tully Hall and Carnegie Hall, Cité de la Musique in Paris and Mexico City's Sala Nezahualcoyotl**, and has participated in masterclasses with Joshua Bell, Midori, Leonidas Kavakos and William Preucil.

An avid chamber musician, Sarah has appeared at several festivals, most notably **Chamber Music International (Dallas), Giverny Hors Les Murs (France), Sarasota (FL), and Marlboro (VT)** where she has performed with such distinguished artists as **Claude Frank, Joseph Silverstein, David Soyer, and Kim Kashkashian**. She was formerly a member of the Atlas Trio and the Dubinsky Quartet, prizewinner at the Fischhoff and Coleman Chamber Music Competitions. Sarah shows great interest in contemporary music as well, and has had the honor to work with several composers on their own compositions, including **Henri Dutilleux, Krzysztof Penderecki and Ned Rorem**. For the past several years, Sarah has performed duo recitals with pianist Jeannette Koekkoek. They most recently played all 10 Beethoven sonatas in Italy to great acclaim, and the cycle was repeated at Indiana University in the summer of 2009.

Sarah received a Masters degree in violin performance at The Juilliard School with Robert Mann in May 2005. She previously received a Bachelor of Music and an Artist Diploma from Indiana University as a pupil of Mauricio Fuks, and formerly studied with Mimi Zweig and James Przygocki at the String Academy of Wisconsin. After receiving a Fulbright Scholarship, Sarah has spent the past two years in Paris as a student at the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique, studying chamber music with Michel Strauss and Vladimir Mendelssohn as member of the **Trio Archiduc**. She also served as concertmaster of the Orchestre des Lauréats du Conservatoire for the 2007-08 season. Currently Sarah divides her professional life between Europe, where she is 1st violin of the **Rubens Quartet** (Netherlands), and the United States, where she plays and tours regularly with the **Orpheus Chamber Orchestra**.

Sarah plays on the "Nico Richter and Hetta Rester" G.B. Rogeri, Brescia ca. 1690, on loan from the Nationaal Muziekinstrumenten Fonds in Amsterdam.
