Hyun-Mi Chung – Biography

Miss Hyun-Mi Chung, a classically trained pianist and concert performer, has just completed her recording of “The Complete Ludwig van Beethoven Sonatas For Piano.” Miss Chung is the first woman in the world to have recorded the entire works of Ludwig van Beethoven Piano Sonatas.

Miss Hyun-Mi Chung was born in Korea and began piano lessons at the age of four. She was soon awarded distinguished prizes, among them first prize in the Honam, Pullma, Pung Moon, and the Competition for Young Pianists. As a young pianist she was one of just a few to be chosen to make a recording at the age of twelve.

In 1975, Miss Chung entered the preparatory division of the Julliard School where she gave two recitals in 1977 and 1978. She earned her Bachelor of Music Degree from Julliard in 1982, and her Master of Music Degree in 1983. While there, she studied with Jane Carlson and William Masselos. Later, she attended the master classes given by Pierre Sancan and had lessons periodically with him in Paris, France.

Miss Chung’s performances include solo concerts in Paris and Nice, France, and concerto performances with the Seoul Philharmonic Orchestra at Sejong Cultural Center, and with the National Orchestra at Seoul National Theater. Miss Chung gave a highly successful debut recital in Korea that was broadcast throughout the country. Miss Chung gave several recitals in the New England area including a benefit concert for the Korean School of New England. She has also performed with Symphony Pro Musica.
