Biography

At the age of 23, Razvan is already an established international artist known at a highest level for his virtuosity, superb interpretation and the integrity of his playing. His recent recording of the 24 Caprices by Paganini, receives great International critical acclaim:

"Disarming charm and ravishing timbre, breathtaking technical bravura, sparkling intonation- he is most likely becoming the greatest violinist of his generation." D Scurtulesco

Growing in a musical atmosphere Razvan Friedmann Stoica takes his first violin lesson at the age four, from his father, a well-known flutist in Romania. At the age of six he attends the "George Enesco Conservatory". After three years he joined maestro Modest Iftinchi at his class, being the youngest pupil admitted at that time.

After graduating Enesco Conservatory he was admitted at the Royal Conservatory in Amsterdam at the class of Ilya Grubert. Razvan's mentor for 10 years was the Romanian pedagogue Modest Iftinchi. He has also worked with Ivry Gitlis, Salvatore Accardo, Stephan Gheorghiu, Berent Korfker, Hermann Krebbers and Ilya Grubert

In 2006 and 2008 he won the first prize in two international competitions, the Perosi Competition Tortona and the "Strad" prize in Salzburg.

He then embarked together with pianist Andreea Stoica on a highly successful career, which has brought performances as a soloist or in recitals in London, Amsterdam "Concertgebouw", Brescia Teatro San Barnaba, Genova Teatro Carlo Felice , Palacio de Festivales, Santander .

Chamber Music has become an integral part of Razvan's life. Since 1996 he was joined by his sister pianist Andreea Stoica in formatting the "Duo Stoica".

The CD's they recorded were exceptionally well received by the international press. According to "Tribuna magazine" the sonata by Debussy can be counted as one of the best recordings of this work.

Razvan Plays on an Antonius Stradivarius 1729 violin loaned to him by an anonymous donor from Salzburg and a violin bow Max Moller Amsterdam courtesy of Montferland Cultuur Fonds.

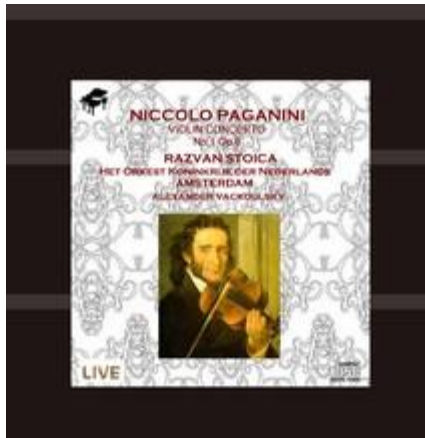
